Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Virtually Inaugurates and Lays Foundation for 7 ESI Projects Nationwide

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 29.10.2024 laid the foundation stones for six new ESI hospitals to expand healthcare services for ESIC beneficiaries across India. These facilities include a 200-bed hospital in Bommasandra, Karnataka; 100-bed hospitals

in Narsapur, Karnataka; Pithampur, Madhya Pradesh; and Meerut, Uttar Pradesh; a 30-bed hospital in Atchutapuram, Andhra Pradesh; and an upgraded ESIC Medical College in Faridabad, Haryana, which will increase its capacity from 650 to 1150 beds.



Additionally, PM Modi inaugurated a new 300-bed ESIC hospital in Indore, Madhya Pradesh, designed to expand to 500 beds, which will benefit around 14 lakh insured individuals. Each of these new facilities will feature advanced amenities, including

modular OTs, ICUs, NICU, PICU, and imaging services, along with liquid medical oxygen plants, CSSD/TSSU units, and nurse call systems, enhancing ESIC's healthcare infrastructure nationwide.



Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya Highlights PM Modi's Vision at Inauguration of 7 ESIC Projects

On 29th October 2024, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Minister of Labour and Employment & Youth Affairs and Sports, shared his significant remarks from the All India Institute of Ayurveda, Delhi, during the inauguration and foundation stone laying of seven ESIC projects nationwide. He emphasized how Hon'ble PM Modi's vision has transformed healthcare, making it accessible and affordable for all, marking a major step towards building a Swasth (Healthy) and Samriddh (Prosperous) Bharat.



Union Minister of Labour & Employment Chairs 3rd Regional Meeting with States/UTs

Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister of Labour & Employment chaired a regional meeting on labour reforms and employment with five western States/Union Territories (UTs)—namely Maharashtra, Goa, Gujarat, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, and Lakshadweep—in Rajkot, Gujarat, on 15 September 2024. Insightful discussions were held regarding the Employees State Insurance (ESI) scheme.

In his address, Dr. Mandaviya emphasized that the Government of India is committed to providing comprehensive and easily

accessible social protection coverage to all workers in both organized and unorganized sectors. He further stated that the Ministry is working with States/UTs to expand the services and benefits of ESIC to all districts in the nation. He added that greater coordination among the Centre, States, and UTs is essential to leverage Information Technology (IT), including Artificial Intelligence (AI), to facilitate beneficiaries' access to quality services. Dr. Mandaviya mentioned that ESIC's Dhanwantari portal will be strengthened for advanced data management in line with global standards.



The Union Minister also highlighted that convergence between ESIS and Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is being planned. "Under this policy, ESIC/ESIS beneficiaries will have access to quality medical facilities in more than 30,000 hospitals empanelled with AB-PMJAY. This

will eliminate distinctions regarding access to services offered by government, public sector, and private hospitals, allowing beneficiaries to efficiently receive treatment in any empanelled hospital," he stated.
